Travel Grants for Ph.D. Students to Present Papers at Conferences

Effective October 1, 2012

The College of Business Administration (CBA) has a travel grant program that provides funds for Ph.D. students who are being financially supported by CBA, to present papers at the major scholarly conferences in their discipline. The full conditions of this grant program are:

1. The student will present or co-present a paper at the conference.
2. Up to \$500 per fiscal year is available from CBA for travel and other conference related expenses. The student's department must match the amount provided by the college.
3. On multiple student authored papers, the funding will be limited to the expenses of one student. The funds could be shared among the student authors. However, if the paper is co-authored with a faculty member, the funding will be available at the full support level of up to \$500 per year.
4. Applications for funding are available from the Department or the Dean's Office. Applications must be processed by the Dean's Office prior to actual travel.
5. In submitting expenses, proof of registration for the conference must be included in order to be reimbursed.
